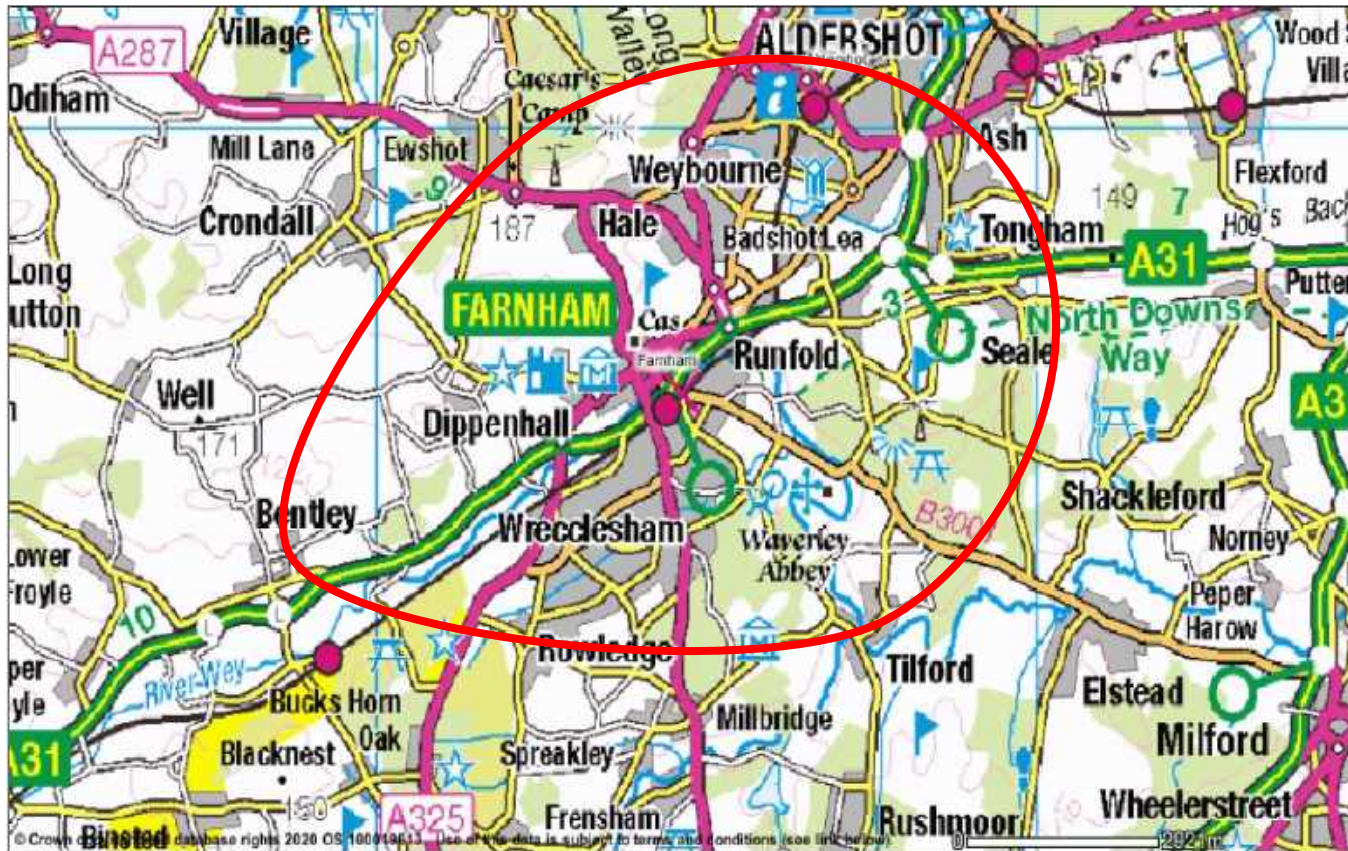
Emerging Draft Vision Statement

The Vision

Deliver a well-integrated, future focused high-quality infrastructure solution for Farnham that enables a connected and vibrant town, where people choose to live, work, study and spend their leisure time in sustainable ways.

Vision – A corridor-wide approach



To ensure a sustainable solution we will take into account:

- WBC Local Plan,
- FTC Neighbourhood Plan,
- Adjacent projects (Brightwells & Woolmead and other mini projects)
- Upcoming influencing projects (Waste centre, LCR station approach)
- Act to enable housing and economic growth
